For directors Graham Hobbs and Ian Tregoning, it is another step forward on what has already proved to be a long journey in getting the approvals underway. The three elements of location, design and facilities have been further enhanced by access to a chapel next door, and the oval and tennis courts of the private St. John's and Concordia Schools.
